Commercial licenses

Individual commercial licenses sector :Volume of Licenses Issued by Economic Sector -1:

The number of individual commercial licenses that the Ministry agreed to issue during November 2020 reached (450) licenses in various economic activities, including (117) licenses in the simple crafts sector, (80) licenses in food sector, marketing, banking and hotels, (36) licenses in textiles and luxuries, (29) licenses in animal and plant products sector, and finally (23) licenses in business services sector.



Volume of licenses with respect to activities:

(450) licenses were classified during one month into several economic activities reaching (10) classifications. Some other activities were not classified due to their small size and large number. Most notably activity was (light food) at a rate estimated about 6% of the total licenses, followed by the activity of (restaurants) at a rate of 5% of the total licenses, followed by the activity of (men's barber shop) at a rate of 4% of the total licenses, followed by the activity of (ready-made clothes, The central market, sewing clothes for women) by 3% of the total licenses for each activity, followed by (steam washing and ironing, general trade, and ladies' beauty salon) at a rate of 2% of the total licenses, and the rest of the licenses for other activities are excused from classification were at rate of 65% from total licenses.



Volume of issued licenses according to geographical distribution (governorates):

Al-Jahra governorate ranked first where the percentage of total licenses collected was about 22%, followed by the Capital Governorate, where it ranked second, with an estimated rate of about 21% of the total licenses. In the third place, Al Farwaniyah governorate comes with an estimated rate of about 20%, followed by Al-Ahmadi governorate, where it ranked fourth with an estimated rate of about 17%, followed by



the fifth place in Hawalli Governorate by 11%, and then Mubarak Al-Kabeer governorate in sixth place with a rate of 9% during October 2020.

3. Volume of licenses for companies of persons issued by activities:

licenses were classified during the month into many economic activities (33) (1,612): activities, with some other activities that could not be classified due to their small size and large number. Most notably, (general trade office) activity was about 17% of the total licenses, followed by (restaurant) activity and general contracting for buildings, at a rate of about 7% and 4% respectively of the total licenses, followed by the following activities (light food, beauty salon Women, import and export, perfumes, ready-made clothes, telephones and their requirements, and food supplies, and foodstuffs) at a rate of about 2% for each activity from the above, and the rest of the licenses for other activities were not classified and they present 35% of the total licenses.



Kuwaiti exports

Total exports of Kuwait origin during November 2020 amounted about 15 million KD, and they were distributed on Gulf countries, Arab countries, and the rest of World. Arabic countries achieved the value of 4 million KD achieving percentage estimated about 25%. The percentage of the rest of the world reached about 21% achieving exports value estimated at about 3 million KD. The value of exports to the Gulf Cooperation Council countries were estimated about 8 million KD and it present 54% of the total exports. It is noted that there has been an increase in the value of total exports relative to last month's exports, which amounted to 32%. Comparing with the same month of last year, there has been an increase in the export percentage estimated about 25%.

First: Exports of Kuwait origin to Al Arabiya Group:

Iraq occupied the forefront of these countries, with exports estimated about 2 million Kuwaiti dinars, at an estimated rate of about 60% of the total exports to Arab countries, followed by exports to Jordan, achieving about 20%, as the total exports were estimated about 763 thousand Kuwaiti dinars, followed by the third place, Yemen, where it achieved a rate of about 4%, and the value of the exports amounted to about 163 thousand dinars. The fourth place was for Algeria, where the value of the exports amounted to about 132 thousand dinars, with an estimated rate of about 4%, and as for the rest of the exports for this month, they were distributed all over Lebanon. Egypt, Syria, Morocco, Palestine, Libya, Sudan, and Tunisia. It is noticeable that the exports of this month increased to Arab countries in relation to last month's exports, which are estimated at about 13%. There has also been a slight decrease in the month's exports to Arab countries compared to the exports of the same month of last year, at a rate estimated about 1%.



Second: Kuwaiti origin exports to other countries of the world:

As for exports to other countries of the world, Turkey occupied the forefront of the world's exporting countries, achieving the value of exports amounted to about 1 million Kuwaiti dinars, with an estimation of 44% of the total exports to other world countries. Belgium ranked second with exports estimated about Dinars, with an estimated rate of about 24% of total exports, and the third place was for India, achieving the total exports amounted to about 292 thousand Dinars with an estimation of about 9% of the total exports to the world countries. As for the rest of the exports of other world countries during this month, they were distributed among all Ukraine, France, Cyprus, Italy, Poland, Liberia, America, Guinea, Britain, Portugal, Greece, Slovenia, Germany, Ethiopia, Pakistan, and Bulgaria. It is noticeable that the exports of the rest of the other countries of the world increased during this month relative to the last month, by an estimated 127%, while there was a clear increase in exports for the rest of the other countries in relation to exports of the same month last year, estimated about 68%.



Third: Kuwait origin exports to Gulf Countries:

As for exports to the countries of the Gulf Cooperation Council, Kingdom of Saudi: Arabia occupied the forefront of the exporting Gulf countries, as the value of their exports amounted to about 3 million Kuwaiti Dinars, with an estimation rate of about 41% of the total exports, and United Arab Emirates ranked second with exports estimated at about 2 million KD by an estimation of 29% of the total exports. State of Qatar ranked third, as its total exports amounted to about 2 million Kuwaiti Dinars with an estimation of 23% of the total exports to the Gulf countries. As for the rest of the exports during this month, they were distributed to each of Bahrain and the Sultanate of Oman. It is noticeable that the exports of the Gulf Cooperation Council countries increased during this month compared to the previous month, by 21%, while there was an increase in the month's exports to the Gulf Cooperation Council countries in relation to the same exports of month in last year with an estimation of 28%.



Precious metals

The ministry stamped about 2 tons of gold during November 2020, compared to about 1.9 tons in November 2019. There was a decrease in the quantities of silver that were stamped during this month compared to November 2019, as it reached about 75 kg during this month, after recording about 104 kg during November of last year. There has been a decrease also in the quantities of valuable stones that were examined and evaluated by the ministry, which was estimated about 69% compared to last November, as the quantities of stones reached 91 pieces during the current month, compared to 290 pieces during last November. The quantity of gold and silver bars reached 2,185 tons during this month, compared to 622,945 kg in November 2019, an increase of 251%.



Giving Support

The Ministry provided within November 2020 support for many of materials, in amount of about 12 million Kuwaiti Dinar (12,354.261 KD), so its support has been .decreased in rate about 7% from last month

The basic materials set which

are provided with the rationing cards for this month got about 7.9 million KD, in percentage of 64% of the aforementioned support, this set contains Beshawer reice, sugar, ordinary powdered milk, vegetable oil, tomato paste, checkins, lentils and .flour

It is noticeable that; its

support has been decreased in percentage of 19% in comparing of last October, but if we add to this set the support of the infants milk and feeders with percentage of 4% of the total support, so the gross total support for Flour Mills Company is about 68% .of the total support provided within November 2020



Also, the previous support amount has been given to the Kuwaiti companies for ration, which total amount was about 8 million KD, its support has been decreased .with percentage of 18% from what was given within last month

The cement support amount

for Kuwait Flour Mills and Bakeries Company and Kuwait Cement Company reached about 397 thousand KD, with percentage of about 3% of the total support, it is noticeable that; its support has been decreased with percentage of about 5% from last month

The iron support amount

which was provided by the Ministry within the month was about 1>06 million KD, which represents about 9% of the month support, it is noticeable that; an increasing .with percentage of about 21% was happened in comparing of the last month

The support of the isolating

white bricks within this month reached about 252 thousand KD, with percentage of 2% of the total support of the month; it is noticeable that; an increasing with percentage of about 52% was happened in comparing of the last month

The conditioning support

reached about 509 thousand KD, with percentage of 4% of the total support of the month; it is noticeable that; an increasing with percentage of about 13% was .happened in comparing of the last month

Concrete support reached

about 740 thousand KD, with percentage of 6% of the total support of the month; it is noticeable that; an increasing with percentage of about 22% was happened in .comparing of the last month

The cementic bricks support

reached about 300 thousand KD, with percentage of 2% of the total support of the month; it is noticeable that; an increasing with percentage of about 29% was .happened in comparing of the last month

Sanitary ware sets support

reached about 85 thousand KD, with percentage of 1% of the total support of the month; it is noticeable that; an increasing with percentage of about 33% was .happened in comparing of the last month

The electrical wires support

reached about 298 thousand KD, with percentage of 2% of the total support of the



month; it is noticeable that; an increasing with percentage of about 14% was .happened in comparing of the last month

Ceramic and porcelain

support reached about 27 thousand KD, with a negligible percentage of the total support of the month; it is noticeable that; an increasing with percentage of about .43% was happened in comparing of the last month

The external cladding support

reached about 253 thousand KD, with a negligible percentage of the total support of the month; it is noticeable that; an increasing with percentage of about 4% was .happened in comparing of the last month

The waterproofing support

reached about one thousand KD, with a negligible percentage of the total support of .the month

It was provided about 402 thousand cement sacks for 238 beneficiaries, 9 thousand tons of iron for 215 beneficiaries, about 19 thousand cubic meters of the isolating white bricks have been provided for 216 beneficiaries, 3 million bricks of the cementic bricks have been provided for 209 beneficiaries, 82 thousand cubic meters of the ready concrete have been provided for 206 beneficiaries, all of these materials have .been provided within November 2020

For the number of beneficiaries by conditioning, they reached 170 beneficiaries, an amount of 850 thousand KD has been provided for them, the number of beneficiaries by sanitary ware sets, they reached 468 beneficiaries, an amount of 138 thousand KD has been provided for them, the number of beneficiaries by ceramic and porcelain, they reached 7 beneficiaries, an amount of 10 thousand KD has been provided for them, the number of beneficiaries by electrical wires, they reached 293 beneficiaries, an amount of 434 thousand KD has been provided for them, the number of beneficiaries by coarse dyes, they reached 122 beneficiaries, an amount of 180 thousand KD has been provided for them within November 2020.




